With about 3,000 employees and Euro 513.4 million in sales in 2008, S&T is the leading provider of IT consulting, IT solutions and IT services to customers in Central and Eastern Europe, the DACH region (Germany-Austria-Switzerland) and also has subsidiaries in Japan and China. Counting around 70 branch offices in 21 countries, the Group has established a successful presence. - Georg Komornyik, COO

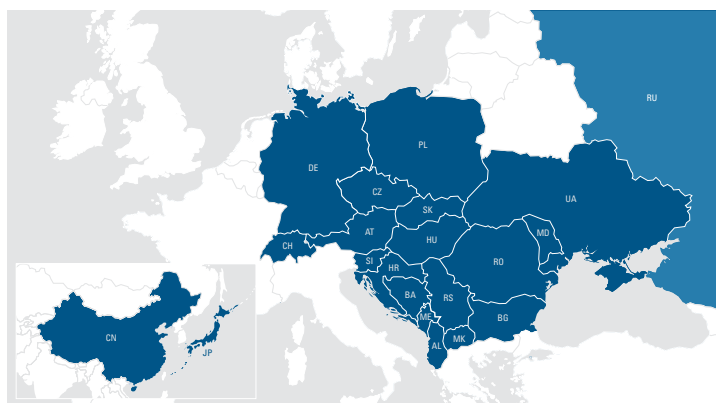
Georg Komornyik has been with S&T since 2006. He heads the division Business Solutions as COO (as from January 2009).

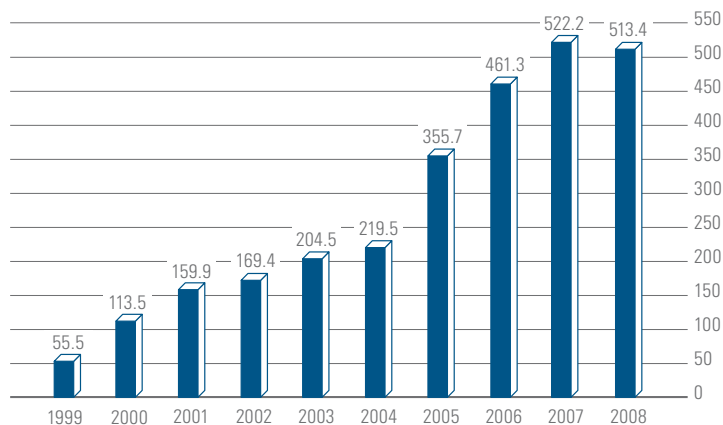
S&T Infrastructure Solutions

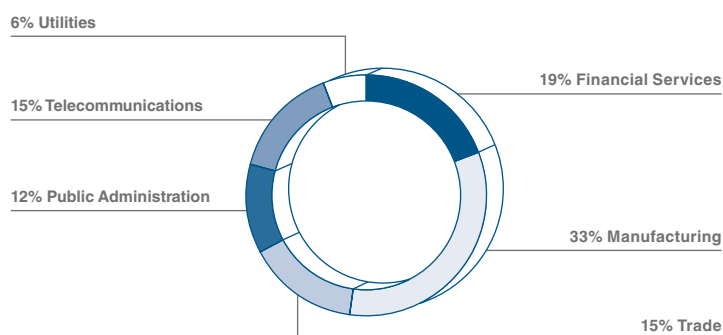
SALES (in million EUR)

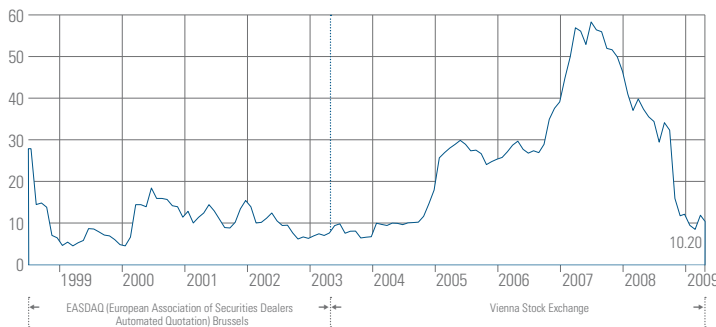
S&T Team
