PROMET® – the methodical road to success

In order to undertake and complete projects successfully, a systematic approach is essential. To fulfill this requirement, the Institute of Business Informatics at the University of St. Gallen has created the concept of Business Engineering, which has been developed in close collaboration with business and industry. On the basis of this concept, The Information Management Group (IMG), acquired by S&T in 2007, has developed the PROMET® (PROcess METHod) methodology. This is a pragmatic refinement of the business engineering concept, and provides templates and procedures for common types of projects and project situations.

SemTalk – an expansion of MS Visio with the addition of process modeling functions

Semtion GmbH's SemTalk tool is based on Microsoft (MS) Visio and supports process documentation and analysis. SemTalk is of particular benefit in situations where the capabilities of dynamic process modeling with Visio are no longer effective. SemTalk combines the powerful visualization functionality of Visio with the performance capabilities of a professional modeling tool, thereby providing and supporting supplementary functions in Visio:

- Versatile and sophisticated navigation structure within and between models
- Model logic and consistency checks
- Reporting functions
- HTML generation
- Interfaces, e.g. to MS Word, MS PowerPoint and MS Excel
- Integration and company-specific adaptation of SAP reference models
- Process simulation
- XML instead of proprietary databases



PROMET@work – Process modeling with the SemTalk tool

PROMET@work is a combination of the PROMET® method and the SemTalk tool, i.e. it provides a holistic approach to process analysis and documentation based on methods and tools. Users can therefore learn how to use PROMET® intuitively within a comparatively short space of time; they are presented not only with a procedural structure that is clearly defined in terms of both time and logic but also with complete process documentation. This documentation can be made available to users either in the form of an electronic manual, using the HTML export, or as a printed manual via the Word interface.
